Greetings from your Waynesboro Community Concert Association.
I am pleased to introduce our 83rd season of presenting quality live
entertainment to our community, which we are calling "a tradition of
excellence". This was the goal in our founding year, 1936, and it continues today.
I'd also like to personally invite each subscriber to help us grow to a target of 600.
We are more than halfway there!

So what is in store for our 83rd season, with all concerts held at 3 PM on Sunday afternoons?

- First up, the **L. A. Party Dolls** present **Girlpower**, a tribute to the greatest '60s era girl groups.
- Next, high energy, crowd engaging **Savannah Jack** brings a concert of country, pop and rock party hits. Leader of the group is Don Gatlin, a cousin to the Gatlin Brothers.
- Tajci**, (say tie-chee), a pop artist from Croatia, will present a musical cabaret style show of the American Songbook, and this will also be our fall Military Appreciation concert.
- In April, siblings, world-renowned tenor Nathan Pacheco, soprano Elizabeth Pacheco Rose, and pianist Rebecca Pacheco as **Trio Pacheco** present a "magical afternoon of love songs" you won't want to miss.
- In May, classical pianist **Thomas Pandolfi**, one of only three performers invited to a third WCCA appearance, presents a completely new program "American Pop Piano". It promises to be an exceptional concert to end the season, which is also our First Responders Appreciation concert.

Subscription pricing is still \$55 for the season, and if you subscribe before the end of May, the cost is only \$50. A new subscription includes the April and May, 2019 concerts. Your season subscription also admits you at no cost to Hagerstown and Gettysburg concert associations' events. Students from kindergarten through high school are admitted free. Tickets for our 83rd season will be mailed in late August or early September, in time for our first concert.

We are looking forward to your membership renewal, and we hope that you can help us to grow. When a new subscriber indicates you referred them, we will reward you with a ticket to bring a friend to a future concert of your choice. It's our way of saying thanks, as well as an opportunity for you to encourage your friends and neighbors to join, and enjoy, our organization.

For several years now, we have separated memberships (your tickets) from donations. Because subscriptions alone cover about 50% of season cost, the more than \$9,000 in donations made by members are critical to our overall financial well-being. There are a number of donor categories we hope may be attractive to you, and we hope to welcome many more members into the "Club for the 80's", a continuing feature for the decade. If you wish you may direct 10% of your donation to the Joseph Bowers Scholarship Fund.


